

# **APA North Sends 6 Teams to the APA National Championships**



Just Having Fun - 8 Ball

A Bit if Billiards hosted the APA of Northern Colorado's Local Team Championships on May 22-23 (9-Ball) and June 5-6 (8-Ball). During the year teams compete in weekly league play attempting to qualify for this event.

On May 22-23 24 9-Ball teams met at The Bit for the 2 day event trying to earn 1 of the 2 spots available to compete at the APA's National Team Championships in August. Using a modified single elimination the teams battled it out on Saturday and Sunday with 9-Lives out of Boulder and Chompin' at the Bit from Longmont CO, both qualifying for the final round. After the long weekend of playing pool and taking into consideration that both teams would be advancing to The APA National Team Championships it was agreed that they would declare a truce to the battle and split the team travel assistance money. Each team walked away with a spot to compete in Vegas, \$3500.00 in travel money, 1 bar trophy, and individual plaques for each member of the team

In 8-ball, Teams qualify from each division of weekly play to compete in a Tri-Cup tournament at which these teams play for 8 spots that advance them to the Local Team Championship, and cash that is paid to the top 4 teams. The top 8 teams from each of the Tri-Cup tournaments then meet at the 8-Ball Local Team Championship, held June 5-6, this year at A Bit of Billiards in Longmont CO. We had 22 teams (2 teams qualified twice during the year) meet at The Bit and played for 4 spots to compete in Vegas. A double elimination format is used played down to the top 2 teams on either side. Our Champions on the "No-Loss" side were Soft Touch out of Ft Lupton CO, and Pure Luck, also out of Ft Lupton each collecting \$4,000.00 in travel money, 1 bar trophy, and individual plaques for each member of the team. The competition on the "One-Loss" side continued on into early Monday morning with the 2 victors being Just Having Fun based in Loveland CO and Shape Shooters playing out of The Bit. Both of these teams earned \$3,000.00, 1 bar trophy, and individual plaques for each member of the team.

Erin and Kevin would to offer their congratulations to all of their qualified teams and wish them the best of luck and a great time out on Vegas.



# **Jump Shots**

#### July 2010

Any beginner in golf who's receiving instruction is likely to hear the age-old but useful piece of advice, "Let the club do the work." We don't hear that about the cue so often in pool, but there are times when that same wisdom applies for us. I find myself offering that advice most frequently to players who are learning jump shots for the first time. For some reason less experienced players tend to attempt the most ambitious jump shots, which makes them try too hard to execute the shot with an elbow-dropping (or raising) swoopy scooper that does nothing to get the cue ball off the table. Sometimes a few failed attempts are discouraging enough to make a player put that jump cue back in the case for good while regretting its purchase. A lightweight jump cue, with its extra hard and wide tip, is designed to jump the cue ball easily with a normal, firm, straight stroke.



a very small jump, not much elevation is required, perhaps 10-20 degrees. Placing the bridge hand on the rail makes achieving that elevation simple and natural. To find the spot you must hit on the cue ball imagine a line going through the cue ball's center at the same angle of your elevation, and then hit the cue ball about a tip below that line with your cue parallel to it. Then with a mediumfirm hit and a light

grip, follow your tip





from the cushion as shown. Because there is not enough space to roll the cue ball between the solids you must jump it to get through them. Doing so requires three basic elements-elevation, а medium-firm stroke and a light grip. Because this is





ploys the same techniques and principles as the easier shot A. Because a jump cue can handle a wider variety of jump shots than a regular playing cue, we learn to adjust our elevation according the shot's setup.

Before moving on to shots with a jump cue let's examine a very simple but instructive jump shot with a regular playing cue as an introduction to the technique for more advanced shots. In Shot A we have two solids exactly one ball width apart and the cue ball five to six inches through the cue ball to the cloth on that line.

Shot B is somewhat more difficult and requires a jump cue, which gets the cue ball off the table higher and quicker because of its lower weight. Although this shot is more advanced it em-

# Multi-Winners Abound at the 2010 ACS Nationals in Las Vegas

So many divisions! So many winners and multidivision champions! As with each of the six National Championships produced by the American CueSports Alliance (ACS) - and this year welcoming its new league and championship sponsor: Lucasi Hybrid Cues - the annual spectacle at the Riviera Hotel & Casino in Las Vegas, June 6-12, showcased formats that encouraged many different winners...in many different formats...for many different skill levels...along with multi-titlists in the higherskilled divisions.

Multi-titlists included the likes of: Debra Aarens (Las Vegas, NV) who anchored the Women's Open 8-Ball Team Champion "Smokin' 8s," the same Women's Open 9-Ball Team runner-ups, and placed as the Women's 9-Ball Singles runner-up; Dustin Gunia (Omaha, NE) who won the Men's 9-Ball Singles crown and shared top honors as well with his Master 8-Ball Scotch Doubles partner, Jessica Frideres (Fort Dodge, IA) [Jessica also anchored the champion Women's Open 9-Ball team "Which Witch Is Which" as well]; Christy Goldsmith (Henderson, NV) who won the Women's Speed Pool Challenge, placed 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Women's Open 8-Ball Singles and 2<sup>nd</sup> again on Vegas's "I Had A Plan" team in the Women's Open 8-Ball Teams; Beth Fondell (Owatonna, MN) who won the coveted Women's Master 8-Ball Singles crown and placed runner-up with partner and Men's Speed Pool Champion, Jerrod Frideres in the Master 8-Ball Scotch Doubles category; Edward Mataya who was runner-up in the Men's Open 8-Ball Singles and anchored both the repeating champion "Malarkey's" Men's Open 9-Ball team from Tacoma, WA and the

same "Malarkey's" Men's Open 8-Ball Team 3<sup>rd</sup>place finisher; and Mary Rayner (Calgary, AB) who captured the Women's Standard 8-Ball Singles title and placed 2<sup>nd</sup> with partner Brian Bird in the Open 8-Ball Scotch Doubles division

The Championships also highlighted its share of first-time national champions: Standard player Kassandra Bein (Virginia Beach, VA) outdistancing some much stronger players to take the handicapped Women's 9-Ball Singles title; Ray Skenandore (Las Vegas, NV) who has improved in the Men's Open 8-Ball Singles field every year until finally claiming the title in 2010; Jeff Heath (Reno, NV) who has always threatened but never claimed the Men's Master 8-Ball Singles title until this year; York Haven, PA's Christine Chamberlain in the Women's Open 8-Ball Singles; Robert White (Conception Bay South, NF) who probably traveled the farthest to take down a title - that of the Men's Standard 8-Ball Singles; Pat Mowdy (Longview, WA) who improved on his runner-up performance in 2008 to take down the 2010 crown in the Men's Senior 8-Ball Singles division; Shawn Modelo (Antioch, CA) who claimed the top award in her rookie year in the Women's Senior 8-Ball Singles; and Milton Strack (Monticello, IL) who - after thirty years of competing in various national championships in Vegas finally claimed a national championship trophy for his case against a very formidable Super Senior 8-Ball Singles field.

In the Open Scotch Doubles contest, Lexington, Kentucky's Samantha Patton teamed up with her league mate, 2009 Super Senior 8-Ball Singles champ Madison Adkins, to claim the top spot; and Madison went on to help his "American Legion Post # 313" (KY) team to win the Open 8-Ball Team title after knocking on that door for the previous five years. Lexington, Kentucky's other powerhouse team, "Mike's Team/Silver Cue," almost brought another national trophy home with a runner-up performance in the Open 9-Ball Team division won by defending champs, Malarkey's of Tacoma, WA. Las Vegas struck again, with the "Tuesday - Rich" team capturing top honors in the Men's Standard 8-Ball Team division, while Texas claimed honors thanks to the performance of team "Flawless" in the Women's Standard 8-Ball Team class. Aside from Scotch Doubles honors, Canada claimed further team honors by capturing the Men's Master 9-Ball Team competition, courtesy of team "Fort McMurray" (AB).

In 2011, the ACS is excited about moving the newly titled Lucasi Hybrid Cues ACS National Championships to the newly renovated Tropicana Las Vegas a month earlier – May 7-14 ! Players will be royally entertained at this legendary anchor on the southern Vegas strip that is transforming itself into the best modern, mid-priced value in Las Vegas. The ACS looks forward to continuing to build its ranks in 2010/2011 through its twelve state associations and championships and its independent leagues, its Lucasi Hybrid All American Tour, and to welcoming players to its \$10,000 added 2011 Midwest 8-Ball Championships, January 20-23 at the Riverside Casino in central Iowa, and to the 2011 ACS Nationals at the Tropicana Las Vegas in May !! 


Now, with this performance that Joseph put on, his rank will be moved to

#### **Question:**

"I am new to billiards and I was wondering what you would suggest I do to improve my shot aiming. I can always see the angle needed to pocket a ball but can never hit it perfectly. Any tips or advice?"

#### Answer:

Pocketing shots is broken down into different parts. 1) Look at the object ball to the pocket. 2) Look at the cue ball to the object ball. 3) Walk into the shot 4) Practice strokes 5) Follow through the shot. 6) Stay down till the cue ball stops rolling.

During my clinics one of the first things I ask my students is "do you have a pre-shot routine"? I proceed and have each of them jot down what theirs is... then I encourage them with mine.

Everyone needs a pre-shot routine – this way you're developing some structure and discipline in your game. We all strive for consistency....

My best advise is to join one of my open clinics- the next one is scheduled for Saturday, July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at the Wynkoop and you can get more infor-

Good posture can really say a lot about a person.

Think about the player that's slumped over in his

chair or practically spilling over the edge of his stool. He's looking all around the room and now he's text messaging his buddies. What impression is this player giving you? Does he intimidate you with his killer instincts? Does he look like he's focused and ready to snap off a tournament?

Next, take a look at the guy that is sitting upright with his cue in his hand, ready for action. He's staring at the table. He's alert and intense. He acknowledges you when you call a shot and he sits deliberately, barely moving when you're at the table. Doesn't he look respectful and professional? Isn't he just oozing of poise and confidence?

Now that you have a visual of these two players, which one are you?

Take a look at my favorite player, world champion Ralf Souquet from Germany. He's a world class player in every respect of the term and no matter what he's doing, he's conducting himself as such. Whether he's sitting, standing, resting, drinking, or waiting to pounce, he carries himself deliberately. Even if he's leaning forward, he's not slouching. Every ounce of his energy is exerted with intent and purpose. They don't call him "The Surgeon" for nothing. Ralf understands the importance of good posture with every move he makes.

Winning Posture Maintaining good posture not only makes you look like a champion but there are countless benefits to

keeping yourself vertical. Here are just a few:

**Good posture facilitates breathing.** Sitting up straight naturally enables you to breathe properly. Poor posture invites restricted, shallow breathing a host of other problems. For an extreme example, bend over and breathe. When you're slouched or bent over, your esophagus, trachea, and other vital parts are all distorted and restricted. Sitting up and breathe deeply. Stay relaxed and calm. Who doesn't want that in their pool match?

#### Good posture increases concentration and

thinking. Better breathing means more oxygen into your body which means more oxygen to the brain. Basically, it helps you think more clearly. I think we can all agree that the ability to think clearly during a pool match is definitely a benefit. Calm your mind and enhance your concentration by staying tall.

Good posture makes you feel better about yourself. Without changing anything else, just start sitting up straighter and notice how much more confident you instantly feel. Test: Slump down in your seat for one minute as you finish reading this article. Then, straighten your back and sit with correct posture for one minute and feel the difference.

Good posture can help avoid health complications. Over time, bad posture can result in a multi-

tude of difficulties. For example, it increases the risk of a slipped disc, back aches and pains, poor blood circulation, and possible pressure inside your chest.

Start by correcting your posture during your matches. Then, before you





realize it, you'll be sitting up straighter even when you're not playing pool.

Be careful not to overcorrect your posture as that can cause back problems too. You want a straight, relaxed spine.

Now, don't forget to switch to your minute of good posture! It will feel so much better than you never go back. Sit tall, feel confident, and having winning posture.



In a nutshell, when the obstruction is closer we elevate the cue higher to get the cue ball off the table more quickly with a tighter arc. To get over an obstruction that's farther away we lower the butt of the cue for a longer arc. In any case we find our spot to hit on the cue ball with the same parallel line technique we used for Shot A. Jump cues differ from one another and so we learn to adjust to our own cues according the shots we face. This shot calls for more elevation than Shot A, perhaps 45 degrees, made easy again with the cue ball near the rail. So, elevating from the rail and applying everything discussed so far, especially a light grip and a follow through that stays on the cue's line, you should be able to pocket that striped ball in the far corner comfortably.

Now, for some real fun, let's try Shot C, which is the same as Shot B except for that second obstructing solid ball just past the side pocket. So, it's time for the jump masse' shot. To pocket the striped ball in the lowerright corner you will do everything you did to execute Shot B with the addition of two more elements. Because you must curve the cue ball

around the second obstruction you will add some right-hand english with the necessary elevation required to jump over the first obstruction. Also, the landing area is critical for success on this shot, and I would begin shooting the cue ball to the X. A cue ball that goes too far will not curve in time to reach the stripe, and if it lands too soon it can curve into the second solid ball. This is not an easy shot but it is fun and a great source of experimentation.

Most jump shots are not all that difficult but they tend to feel foreign at first, which can make them a challenge to shoot comfortably. It's always best at first to practice modest shots with a focus on comfort and confidence while you feel the cue doing the work. It's also a good idea to ask an experienced player to watch you shoot a few with an eye on your form. For more instruction and detailed explanations consult Disc V of the Video Encyclopedia of Pool Shots where Dr. Dave and I offer extensive analysis for 37 different jump and masse' shots including Shot C, which serves as a coda for those two sections.


