





# Versatility of the Stop Shot

Reprinted from January 1999

Very often, maybe incessantly, I tell students that in order to become great players they must master the stop shot. More than any technique in pool the stop shot removes randomness and turns probability into certainty. On a straight-in shot where the shooter can stop the cue ball dead he knows precisely where the cue ball will come to rest. On a cut shot the player knows when he executes a stop shot that the cue ball will follow the track off of the object ball perpendicular to the ball's path to the pocket. In both cases the stop shot removes guesswork from the position play and offers the player confidence rather than hope.

Once mastered the stop shot also serves as a reliable reference point or benchmark. This month we shall examine that aspect of the stop shot while learning a couple of shots in the process. Set up the shot in the diagram and place the cue ball at position X. From there shoot some stop shots hitting the cue ball just below center with medium-firm speed and a

good punch stroke. After you are stopping the cue ball consistently you can begin to adjust your hit on the cue ball for some stun shots.


While preparing to shoot put your tip on the cue ball where you would hit it for a stop shot and then move it up a hair, maybe a sixteenth of an inch, to hit a stun shot with some follow. Shoot the shot with the same speed and punch stroke until the cue ball is moving for-

punch stroke until the cue ball is moving forward just a few inches after hitting the object ball. When you are hitting stun-follow shots

consistently you can try the same thing for stun draw by adjusting your tip down slightly and doing everything else the same way. The stun-draw shot should, despite the firm stroke, move the cue ball back just a few inches off of the object ball.

These two stun shots are essential to a complete pool game and very useful in many situations where normal follow and draw shots are too difficult to control for such minor cueball movement. Set up a long shot and try the same two shots with follow and draw strokes and the soft speeds needed to move the cue ball so slightly. Usually the shot is extremely difficult and sometimes impossible to control when played so softly. Imagine playing the shot this softly to control the position on a table that may not be level.

#### **Question:**

*Is it possible to hold the cue too loosely and does the grip pressure change* at all through the stroke? I know the natural tendency is to tighten up on forward stroke/impact, but should I concentrate on avoiding that?

#### **Answer:**

Holding your cue the correct way is an important component of your mechanics. Below are some photos to help you visualize what you should/ should not do. When it comes to your grip, the best way that I can describe it is; its as if your holding on to a bird - you don't want to let him go but at the same time you don't want to kill the poor thing.

If you hold on to your cue with a tight grip as if it's a bat then your stroke will be limited to the back and forth motion. If your grip is too soft then your follow through will not be secure enough. Cradle your cue in your hand lightly around all of your fingers. Do not include your palm otherwise your grip will become too tight.

Remember to keep your wrist straight up/down without having a crease as shown in the second photo. Also, most important keep your thumb around your cue not on top of your cue.

### What's New at the BCAPL National Championships? by OMG

#### Monday, May 17, 2010

In my wanderings [at the BCA Nationals], I noted terminals set up near the control desk of the tournament room. This year, CSI rolled out its **CTS** (**CueSports Tournament System**) for the National 8-Ball Championships. It had already been in use for regional tournaments but this was the first at a national level. From what I've been told, this tournament bracket system has been a long time and a lot of money in the making.

It's freaking awesome.

Here is a breakdown of the system as told to me by CSI.

#### For players:

- It gives you more time and eliminates frustration, especially if you're in a tight running tourney. You don't have to actually walk over to the paper tournament boards posted by the control desk to check when and where you will be playing next (although I still do this out of nervous habit for every match) which generally keeps you leashed to the immediate vicinity of the Riviera.
- The kiosks in the area also allow for orderly viewing of a tournament chart (instead of a massive crush of people all straining to read tiny, tiny print y'all know what I mean).

#### For spectators/fans:

• Once you enter player's name, it automatically searches entire brackets (even if there are multi-

ples used for one event) and pops into the correct spot, with the match time and table number.

• You can also see a snap shot of match results of a player: who they matched up, won and lost to, and even where their opponents finished.

#### For event promoters/directors:

- When searching for players' known ability: every event, finish, and opponents won and lost to are archived for easy search by players' name.
- It practically eliminates human error because the system runs the tournaments for you.
- Players start with a barcoded score sheet.

Once the match is over with the win-loss score noted, the scoresheet is returned to the tournament desk. The barcode is scanned and loser's score is recorded next to his/her name. The program automatically generates the next match in the bracket for both winner and loser and then prints next set of barcoded score sheets.

Everything is updated in real-time (as fast as updating can allow) and accessible via the intrawebs. Many cell phones nowadays have internet access. This means that you can now look up, on your phone (or computer), when and what table you will be playing on next. Even more fantabulous is the following:

We also have text message and email notification service for match time and schedule in final testing stage of development. Players will provide their cell phone number (messaging fees as



charged by your service provide may apply) or email address. It is tied into CTS and was tested at the U.S. Bar Table Champions this year.

The message will inform you of your upcoming match time and table number:

"Congratulations, Peter Pan. You defeated Captain Hook and your next match is 2:30 pm on table #34."

It's a tournament player/results junkie/stalker's dream. Oh, and a pool blogger's dream, too — since now I can directly link you, gentle reader, to the tournaments of which I write. As long as the tournaments use CTS, of course.

# Feature Business of the Month

# APA of Northern Colorado By David Hakala

The Northern Colorado APA League franchise is rich with amateur players and growing rapidly. Approximately 185 teams play in and around Boulder, Longmont, Estes Park, Fort Lupton, Greeley, Fort Collins, Firestone, Frederick, Lafayette, and Louisville. This lively, expanding pool scene owes its vigor to the hard work and savvy leadership of Kevin and Erin Leivonen.

The Leivonens hail from New Jersey, where they married 15 years ago. They have three children together plus Kevin's older daughter, Jenny. The kids all play pool although four year-old daughter Riley, the youngest, is just at the "pushing balls around the table" stage, says Erin.

Kevin first played APA in 1991. It was hard to find league venues in New Jersey, he says. Bars had only one or two tables, if any, because New Jersey's laws made it difficult to serve liquor where pool was played. There was no official APA league so in 2003 Kevin started one. He grew it to over 80 teams during the next 5 years. Then Kevin and Erin reached a crisis point in their lives.

Their family was growing. The pool league was growing. Kevin's job in the medical ultrasound profession was full time and then some. Something had to go. The Leivonens had the courage to let the job go, putting their children and their pool passion ahead of false "security." They also had a hankering to move West, and fate conspired to help them in a timely "coincidence."

Through the APA national organization, Kevin learned that the Northern Colorado franchise was available. Colorado was on the Leivonens' short list of places to live, and the opportunity to take over a thriving league territory iced the cake. Kevin moved here in December, 2008, while Erin and the kids remained in New Jersey until their house was sold six months later. Kevin and Erin have been hard at work ever

since, promoting pool and league play in many innovative ways.

Advertising (in the Cue Times, of course!) has proven effective, says Kevin. Many people are not even aware that APA leagues exist until they run across an ad. Erin always carries fliers to stores, supermarkets, beauty salons, etc., and is not at all bashful about talking up the game of pool and the league.

The couple consistently recruits new venues, and not just bars. Community/senior recreation centers are semi-secret pool venues, for instance. The meeting halls of service organizations often have tables. Going beyond the bar scene, the Leivonens reach new categories of potential players and recruit venues where non-drinkers feel at home.

"I like pool, but I can't play well enough" is the most common objection to joining a league that the Leivonens run into — and they love to hear it. That's because it gives them a chance to explain the APA's handicap system, which gives a novice an even chance to beat an expert. Far from being looked down upon, rookie players are in great demand on every APA team.

It's hard for non-league players to believe that APA team captains positively crave players with lower skill ratings of 2 or 3. But it's true, because they enable more match-up flexibility and a larger team. Under APA rules, the sum of the skill ratings of all team members cannot exceed 23, and a team must field five players per match. So a pair of 2s will fit on a team roster while a pair of highly skilled 6s will not. That's why novices are always welcome – eagerly sought, actually.

"It's all about having fun, not just winning," says Erin,

"although there is the potential reward to going to Vegas" for the national championships and all the prestige and excitement of that achievement... not to mention the prize money!

Kevin is especially keen to offer special events to entertain and educate players and non-players. Recently, he brought legendary trick shot artist Mike Massey to the Bit of Billiards in Longmont for a day of amazing feats and humorous banter about the game, the pros, and life in general (See our interview with Mike on page 12).

"This sort of thing is good for the venues as well as the players," says Kevin, noting that more than 80 people ate and drank and played pool at Massey's exhibition. Quite a few of them did not play pool often, but became interested in the game and league play while watching Massey's magic.

The Northern Colorado APA League is in excellent, hard-working hands. The Leivonens plan to grow the league to about 250-300 teams over the next five years. It's their full time passion and commitment.

# Mile High Pool Leagues Send Nine Teams to Las Vegas for APA **National Team Championships**



Nine APA teams from the western and northern Denver suburbs are heading to

Las Vegas for the 2010 APA National Team Championships in August after qualifying at the Mile High Pool Leagues City Championships at the Jefferson County Fairgrounds Exhibition Hall the last weekend in June.

Four 8-ball teams qualified for the Open 8-Ball National Team Championship conducted by the American Poolplayers Association (APA) - Zooperb from Zoosters, More Hokey than Pokey from Zoosters, Shark Bait from Love's Shack and Got Chalk from Greenfields.

# Back to Pool!

It's that time of the year again! As the leaves turn, the kids return to school and the fall pool league season begins. Do you have any plans for a

better season this year? Enjoy this easy checklist and have a fun pool season!

#### 1. Set a Goal

One great thing about league is that someone else is keeping the stats *for* you. Now would be an ideal time to set some tangible, measurable goals. Maybe you'd like to move up by one handicap. Maybe you want a higher win percentage. Whatever your objective is, keep your eye on the target and have a plan of attack.

Kids come home with progress reports that show their development. These stats may indicate their areas for improvement. Granted, the league stats won't identify the shots you miss most often or how many times you broke dry, but most will show ERO's (Earned Run-Outs) and win-loss percentages. Use these stats to track your progress throughout the league season.

#### 2. Keep it Simple

Choose one new shot or exercise to focus on. This should be something that allows you to target a specific weakness in your game. Perhaps you're struggling with safeties or you have a phobia of inside english. If you have trouble identifying your weaknesses, ask a teammate for help. Try to dedicate at least 10 hours to each new drill before moving to the next one. Track your progress as you go along.

#### 3. Continuing Education

Pick up a book, watch some videos, surf the internet, or simply read through the rest of this publication. There are so many great resources out there to help you get started. Many of them won't even cost you a dime! If you need to be pointed in the right direction, let me know.

#### 4. Review and Repeat

Now remember, even though you're using the league stats, your goals should be performance based and <u>not</u> outcome based. When you do your best and work to improve your weaknesses, the results will follow. If all your opponents break and run out on you in league, the outcome was negative but that was not a reflection of your performance.

Take some time to review your stats from previous seasons and periodically check on your standings in the current season. Have fun with your new goals and enjoy going back to pool!



## Mike Massey Wows Audience During Recent Visit to Colorado

One of pool's bestloved legends thrilled a crowd of over 80 excited fans

on July 11<sup>th</sup> in Longmont, at the Bit of Billiards Sports Bar and Grill. Mike Massey, trick shot artist par excellence, put on a four hour exhibition and played APA 8-ball with ten lucky challengers drawn from the audience. It was an afternoon to remember! After the exhibition, Mike sat down with the Cue Times to reveal a side of himself that fans rarely see.

Five members of the audience, drawn at random from a bowl of raffle tickets, got to play "The Tennessee Tarzan," as the burly man from Loudun is known.

Mike's stroke is as smooth as the polish on a diamond and as straight as its facets' edges. He did not waste any energy; each ball rolled instead of soaring, and when they hit each other they clicked instead of cracking. Treated gently, the balls obligingly did as Mike bade them. Many players could stand to learn that lesson.

"The (bar) table is only 100 inches long," he often tells players. "This isn't golf."

Mike dominated most of his games, of course. A couple of players got lucky, or played far beyond themselves... or something. They won and ribbed Mike, who took it with perfectly good-natured aplomb, like he was used to being beaten by shortstops. Actually, he gets plenty of practice at winning and losing with local players.

Mike says he currently puts on "over 90" exhibitions per year, driving from town to town with his wife, Francine; two Shih Tzu and one Maltese dog. That's on top of 70 APA clinics he's conducted in the past year!

"Sometimes I'll do 15 shows in a week, then take a couple of weeks off," said Mike. He aims to book his appearances only two to three weeks in advance, so that the initial excitement of "Mike Massey's coming to town!" is still fresh when he arrives. Otherwise, people tend to forget the date or "something comes up." Francine wants Mike to book six months in advance; some time in the middle is what he's "shootin' for"

This grueling schedule is a lighter load than Mike carried in the past, believe it or not. He has left the Trick Shot Masters tour, dissatisfied with the proliferation of elaborate props; "It ain't pool any more," he notes.

But Mike bows deeply to Semih Sayginer, the diminutive, dapper Turkish 3-cushion trick shot artist.

"Semih's the best (artistic pool player) in this world," Mike swears. For his all-around "best player ever," Mike names Efren Reyes. (No argument from here; Efren is a pool god!)

"What would you be doing now if you hadn't committed yourself to pool," I

asked Mike. He didn't know.

"I had an unusual childhood," Mike puts it mildly. Before he took up pool regularly at age 13, he was gambling at cards and doing other things for which we now have electronic ankle monitor programs. His first encounter with a cue was even earlier, at age 8, with a bumper pool table. That's when Mike discovered his talent, or destiny.

"It was like I almost knew what I was doin' " with a pool cue the first time he picked one up, Mike says.

His family was impressed, especially his father who took Mike into Wicker's Tavern in Loudon to play bumper pool, despite Tennessee statutes. "Good men do not obey laws too well," as Ralph W. Emerson wrote.

One night, Mike recalls, his father got a hankering for moonshine and took off in the pickup truck, leaving Mike at bumper pool in Wicker's. Dad returned spectacularly.



#### **Stop Shot**



Now move the cue ball to position Y and shoot some stop shots. Shoot the shot until you are tracking the cue ball consistently along the solid line with the same medium-firm speed. You can place a ball at position A on the solid line and shoot more stop shots until the cue ball is hitting that ball consistently. While keeping a ball at position A shoot some stun-follow shots to track the cue ball between the obstructing ball and the side pocket. Using this technique you should find it rather easy to track the cue ball consistently. Shoot some shots now with stun draw to track the cue ball between the obstruction and the center of the table. Using the stop shot as a reference gives you precise control over the cue ball when adjusting its track for position play. When you need a track that lies close to the perpendicular line this technique is far more powerful than merely trying to create the track you need from thin air.

From this reference point you can begin to adjust the cue ball's track in both directions. Making sure to use a punch stroke for each shot you can vary the speed and the spot on the cue ball you choose to hit a range of cue ball tracks. First work with the top half of the cue ball and then the bottom half. Because you are using a punch stroke for every shot you will not be working with the full range of tracks available for this shot. Instead you will discover your punch or stop-stroke range of cue ball tracks. This will give you feel to control the cue ball's path very precisely as you begin to compare the track that you want to the stop-shot track and adjust from there. As you approach mastery with the stop shot you will begin to associate the punch stroke with reliability and consistency while you find yourself controlling the cue ball with precision and confidence



"There was this huge BOOM out front and when I went outside there was Dad, upside down in the truck. He'd tried to slide into a parking space at 65 miles an hour."

Surprisingly, Dad made it out of this alive. But his feat left a lasting impression on young Mike.

Mike grew up a classic hustler, riding from town to town in search of matches and stakehorses. He had a few "regular jobs" including a stint in the military; five years as a firefighter; and some construction work. But his long-term career was pool, and at first he went down the Dark Side.

Alcohol, drugs, and other things nearly killed Mike, he admits. One night, he didn't dump a match when he was told to, and he found himself locked in the back office of nightclub with a Smith & Wesson, a Luger, and a knife waving all around him.

Fortunately, patrons of the club banged on the door until Mike's "patrons" let him go – without his winnings, of course - with a warning to never come back to that town.

"As if they had to say that," adds Mike with rueful grin. "Other times, it was the cops who told me to get out of town and never come back."

Mike had a spiritual epiphany just in time. "If it wasn't for the Lord I'd a been dead a long time ago," he says. Pool became a vehicle for spreading the Gospel. And then it got weird...

Decades after Dad's truck flip, Mike appeared on Pat Robertson's "The 700 Club" televangelist program. He told the tale of Dad and the moonshine, and right in the middle of it Jimmy Wicker, who still owned the tavern where Mike learned bumper pool and saw his father nearly die, tuned in to the show and cried,

"That's little Mikey!"

"Now, what are the odds against that?" asks Mike. It's as Albert Einstein said, "There are only two ways to look at things: either nothing is a miracle or everything is a miracle." Mike believes in miracles, and so do many of his fans.

Indeed, several Longmont fans requested Christian mottos with the autographs Mike signed for them. Mike works with Steve Lillis of Gospel Trick Shots ministry to spread the Word through exhibitions (www.GospelTrickShots.org). But wait, it gets better!

Mike writes and sings Gospel music. During our interview he sang for me, in a voice reminiscent of Kenny Rogers, about a pool hustler who goes to "a place where there are no losers." Mike

will be adding his tunes to his pool instruction and trick shot videos on YouTube "pretty soon now."
